*Kindergarten will be having lunch at 11:20 (pd 4) on Monday, Thursdays and Fridays. We will be having our "Mix it Up" at lunch on Tuesdays and Wednesdays at 1:00 (pd 6).

Afternoon dismissal will take place on the 8th side of the building where the students line up in the morning. In case of inclement weather they are to arrive to the cafeteria through the right door of the front steps on 6th avenue.

Please note that for your child's safety and protection that we are requiring each one parent/ guardian to please wait until we acknowledge you by making eye to eye contact before you take your child for the line at the end of the day. Dismissal is a hectic

part of the day and this system of us making eye contact and waving to you before we send your child to you helps us a great deal. Our policy, especially for the beginning of the year, is that your child return a popsicle stick to us that has his/her name on it so that we can see who has been picked up and who is still left at a glance. Also, for your child's safety and protection we ask that if you aren't picking up your child that day that you send in a note at the beginning of the day stating the change in the pick-up status. You may also email this note to us ,but please do so at least the day before to ensure that we have seen it. School policy is that phone calls to the office stating changes for pick up will not be accepted. Written notification is required with a signature.

Another reminder is that it is important that every student wear sneakers to school every day of the week in the event that our special class schedule changes. This will ensure that even if your child has gym on an unexpected day, they are prepared to participate appropriately. Although we try to stick to our daily schedule, sometimes changes cannot be avoided.

Every Tuesday afternoon between 2:40-3:25 has been designated by the DOE as Parent Engagement Time. These 40 minutes have been set aside for face to face meetings, telephone conversations, and written correspondence (including email) with parents. Please take advantage of this time to communicate with me as needed across the school year. Although this specific time has been provided it is not the only time that I'm available to meet or speak with parents. We'll be communicating regularly. School/family communication is important at PS 39!
